
Public Works Operations Report: June 2022

The following chart displays areas of focus and percentages for all work performed during the month:



The following list provides items of mention for the month including tasks completed and underway:

- All employees attended training sessions for MS4, confined spaces and chainsaw safety.
- Designated employees attended a recycling meeting and a PA One Call 811 meeting.
- Milling, blacktopping, and sealing occurred on Highland Drive, Village Road, Warwick Road, and Strafford Road; over 12-tons of blacktop were used in total.
- Replaced storm inlet tops on Arthur Drive and Conway-Heath.
- BMP basin mowing at Dairy Farmers/Gettysburg Road and Public Works leaf pad and pond.
- Hauled Diamond-Tex to the LACP for ball fields.
- Drain clearings after rain events, including drain clearing at Lower Allen Shopping Center.
- Leaf turning and cleaning of County's leaf machine before returning.
- Completed spraying of parks and right of ways, mowing, and street sweeping.
- Removed brush and mulched Police gate area.
- Prepared and constructed a stone pad area for pipe and drain boxes near upper shed.
- Prepared Public Works facility interior/exterior for employee picnic.
- Street sign maintenance occurred and will continue.
