PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT FEBRUARY, 2021

There were 8 snow events during February. While most of these storms did not deliver more than 3-4 inches of snow at a time, each storm required a lot of plow time. We did expend approximately 730 tons of road salt, during the month. 500.0 gallons of salt brine was used, to pre-treat roads. Many of these storms were too wet to use the pre-treatment, but it is a great tool for the dryer types of snow. Bring on spring!

The LACP Barn has been having some work done on its restrooms, which includes new stalls and toilet fixtures. A changing room was added to the lower level of the barn, and the kitchen area is getting a face lift as well. The Barn will be ready to go, in the hopes that COVID restrictions; for indoor events, will increase by May.

New aluminum bleachers were purchased for Pete's Field. Our Maintenance Specialists will be building a new shed and transporting it to Pete's, when completed. These items were damaged, by an unfortunate, vehicle accident; late last year.

During February the following projects were completed:

- Tree trimming and debris pickup at all parks
- Emptied and washed trucks a few times during the month
- Removed and installed snow plows several times during the month
- 2 Sign repairs/replacements
- Storm water grate cleaning in selected areas
- Cleaned and greased the pump on Seneca

Projects continued:

- Pot hole patching in selected areas, with cold mix
- Cleaned up cold mix from a driveway and yard on Kingsley
- Playground equipment and bench repairs
- Cut back underbrush and dead tree's at Beacon Hill Radar site
- Transported summer equipment from LACP, for yearly maintenance
