MONTHLY REPORT September 2021

The Public Works Building is open. Residents will need to stop in the office to check in before proceeding to drop off brush, bulk items or picking up wood chips. Public Works will be open the second Saturday of the month, 8:00am – 1:00pm, running through November. Households within the township can drop off 4 loads each, of brush and bulk items per year. Additional loads will be \$25.00 each, to be pre-paid at the Municipal Services Center. Electronics cannot be accepted at this location. Cumberland County E-Recycling Center, is open for recycling TV's, computers/monitors, etc. Information concerning hours of operation and recycling guidelines, can be viewed on the County website at www.ccpa.net.

Leaf collection will start on October 25th and continue through the 1st week of December. Leaves will not be collected during the Thanksgiving holiday break, November 26th – 30th.
