



E-NEWS ALERTS FROM PENN WASTE (SIGN UP)

Trash services are billed through Lower Allen Township but collected by Penn Waste. Please see their website for more information about refuse services at <https://www.pennwaste.com>.

MISSED COLLECTION – REPORT DIRECTLY TO PENN WASTE

If Penn Waste should miss a **trash, recycling, or yard waste collection**, please notify them by 7 AM the next morning by utilizing the [Report a Missed Pick Up](#) form. This form is reported directly to the Penn Waste Route Supervisor, who can typically send a driver out to pick up the missed collection within 24-48 hours.

You can also report a missed collection through Penn Waste's [Missed Pickup](#) form or by calling (717) 767-4456.

Please note that yard waste collection is typically scheduled for the same day as your trash collection; however, **when Penn Waste is short on staff or vehicles, collection efforts for trash and recycling are prioritized, and collection for yard waste and bulk waste items may be delayed or pushed closer to the end of the week (Saturday).**

BROKEN OR MISSING TOTER – SCHEDULE FREE REPLACEMENT THROUGH PENN WASTE

If your trash or recycling toter is broken or missing, please call Penn Waste at (717) 767-4456 to schedule the delivery of a replacement, or complete Penn Waste's [Broken Container](#) form.

Delivery can take a few weeks to a few months, depending on availability of toters.

Once your replacement is scheduled and until the toters are delivered by Penn Waste, please leave your trash in bags and recycling items in cardboard boxes curbside. If your toter is not delivered within the designated time, please contact Penn Waste for an update.

BULK ITEM COLLECTION – SCHEDULE THROUGH PENN WASTE

Penn Waste allows one bulk item pick-up per week, but it **must be scheduled directly through Penn Waste** by calling (717) 767-4456 or by completing Penn Waste's [Request Large Item Pickup](#) form.



YELLOW YARD WASTE BINS – PURCHASE / PICK UP AT 1400 ST JOHNS RD

Yellow yard waste bins are available for purchase at our Lower Allen Public Works Maintenance Facility, located at 1400 Saint Johns Road, Camp Hill, PA 17011. The facility is open to the public Monday through Friday 8 AM – 2:30 PM and the 2nd Saturday of each month from 8 AM – 1 PM. Summer hours may vary, please contact (717) 975-7575 to confirm hours June through August. The first bin for the property is free, and any additional or replacement bins can be purchased for \$13 each. We are not able to deliver yard waste bins to your property.

COLLECTION DELAYS DUE TO WEATHER/HOLIDAYS/TRAFFIC SAFETY

Collection services are sometimes delayed by **1 or more days** due to weather (extreme heat, snow/ice, excessive rain), holidays (6 holidays), traffic safety issues, etc. Please visit our website news section to see specific information about your waste collection, including schedule, delays, and holidays.

EXTRA BAGS OUTSIDE OF TOTES

Per our contract, Penn Waste will only collect whatever is inside your trash and recycling totes; they will not collect extra bags, boxes, or miscellaneous items alongside the can.

DISPOSAL OF CARDBOARD BOXES

To dispose of cardboard boxes, we have a recycling dumpster located at Lower Allen Community Park, 4075 Lisburn Road, Mechanicsburg, PA 17055, where paperboard and cardboard can be recycled per posted park hours.

DISPOSAL OF ELECTRONICS

Penn Waste is not permitted to collect electronics (such as televisions) through curbside collection. For information about electronics recycling, please contact Goodwill Keystone Area, Cumberland County Recycling & Waste Authority, or retailers such as Best Buy.



DISPOSAL OF CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS

Penn Waste is not permitted to remove construction debris through curbside collection. Please contact Penn Waste or another hauler directly for information about dumpster rentals. Please contact the Township if you will be placing your dumpster in the roadway.

LEAF COLLECTION – MID-OCTOBER THROUGH MID-DECEMBER

Leaf collection is provided by Lower Allen Township and runs mid-October through mid-December each year; please see our [Leaf Collection](#) page for more information.

LIVE CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION – JANUARY

Live Christmas tree collection is provided by Lower Allen Township for two specific weeks in January each year, based on your trash collection day. Please be sure to remove all ornaments, lights, electronics, decorations, tinsel, base, plastic wrap, or anything else. The live tree must be completely bare for removal. REFUSE COLLECTION SERVICES – NEW RESIDENTIAL CONSTRUCTION

Collection services are available immediately upon moving into your new property. Penn Waste will deliver two large toters to your property – one for trash and one for recycling. **Delivery often takes a few weeks to a few months depending on availability of toters and drivers.** Until the toters are delivered by Penn Waste, please leave your trash in bags and recycling items in cardboard boxes curbside. If your toter is not delivered within the designated time, please contact Penn Waste for an update. Once your toters are delivered by Penn Waste, they will only collect whatever is inside your trash and recycling receptacles; they will not collect extra bags, boxes, or miscellaneous items alongside the can.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION – MARCH THROUGH OCTOBER

Curbside yard waste pick up is available from March through October each year and follows the trash collection day schedule. You can put the trash can, recycling bin, and open yard waste containers or biodegradable bags out for pick up on your scheduled trash collection day, typically 3 feet apart if possible.

Please note that yard waste collection is typically scheduled for the same day as your trash collection; however, **when Penn Waste is short on staff or vehicles, collection efforts for trash and recycling are prioritized, and collection for yard waste and bulk waste items may be**



delayed or pushed closer to the end of the week. Please leave your yard waste bins curbside until they are able to collect.

Sometimes, yard waste does not qualify for collection because it contains grass clippings, dirt, treated wood, etc. Typically, Penn Waste will place a sticker on your yard waste bin indicating the reason for non-collection.

REFUSE COLLECTION BILLING CHANGES

Any billing changes to your quarterly refuse collection services must be requested by the property owner in writing and approved by Lower Allen Township. If you would like to request a change in the size of your toters, or to add an additional Standard large trash toter to your service, please complete the “Request to Change Size of Trash Can” form and email it to utilitybilling@latwp.org.

For 2026:

\$112.59/Q: Low Flow small toters 35-gal capacity – approximately 2-3 kitchen garbage bags

\$117.87/Q: Standard large toters 96-gal capacity – approximately 9 kitchen garbage bags

Adding a second Standard large 96-gal trash toter adds \$117.87 to your current quarterly bill.

Lower Allen Township will make the requested changes to the account and pass the request to Penn Waste. Penn Waste will schedule a transfer of toters. Once the transfer of toters is scheduled with Penn Waste by Lower Allen Township, residents can call Penn Waste for updates at (717) 767-4456 if needed. Delivery of new toters is subject to Penn Waste’s availability of toters and drivers to deliver.
