Curbside?

- Place newspaper, junk mail, magazines, copy paper and envelopes in brown paper bags for curbside recycling.
- NEVER use plastic bags in curbside recycling containers. These can tangle and cause damages or injuries at collection facilities.
- Recycle cardboard boxes, cereal boxes, gift boxes, and other thin paperboard at Lower Allen Community Park.
- Pizza boxes are NOT recyclable. Most contain residue and grease after use. Food residue and grease make the box not recyclable. IF the top of the box is free from residue, cut it off and recycle. IF NOT, place the entire box in the trash.
- Consider donating paper bags to home composters and gardeners.

Solid Waste Collection Postponed... Remove your carts from the curb

Tis the season for winter weather which means that school is delayed, businesses are closing early and solid waste collection is postponed or canceled. If your collection day is postponed, please do not place wheeled carts curbside until 6pm the evening before the collection is scheduled to occur. Leaving wheeled carts curbside or placing them curbside prematurely can create neighborhood issues. Lower Allen Township has an ordinance that requires trash and recycling containers to be placed in designated pick up locations after 6pm the night before and removed after collection. Wheeled carts left for longer than the ordinance allows can contribute to littering, cause hazards in roadways, and be an impediment to crews working on the roads. Glass containers do not contain microplastics and have an increase in returns since some locations give a deposit back for the return of glass bottles. In PA, glass can increase tonnage for curbside collection. The higher the weight the Township recycles curbside, the higher the grant money received.
