NOTICE IS HEARBY GIVEN that the Board of Commissioners of Lower Allen Township, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania, enacted the following ordinance at its meeting on Monday, July 13, 2026, commencing at 6:00 p.m., prevailing time, at the Lower Allen Township Municipal Services Center, 2233 Gettysburg Road, Camp Hill, Pennsylvania 17057.

A summary of the Ordinance is as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LOWER ALLEN TOWNSHIP, CUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 220, ZONING, OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF LOWER ALLEN TOWNSHIP, 2023, TO AMEND SUBSECTIONS §220-6. C. DEFINITIONS, §220-56 PERMITTED USES, §220-64 PERMITTED USES, §220-80 PERMITTED USES, §220-88 PERMITTED USES, PERMITTED USES, §220-187 NOISE, & §220-208 ELECTRIC AND WATER INFRASTRUCTURE FOR DATA CENTERS, SEWAGE DISPOSAL, DECOMMISSIONING, AUXILIARY POWER GENERATING SYSTEMS, AND OFF-STREET PARKING BY ACTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

No substantive changes were made to the Ordinance after the public hearing. However, provisions related to the protection of water wells were added to the text.

A full copy of Ordinance No. 2026-04 may be examined at the Municipal Services Center, address as stated above, Monday through Friday, during the hours of 8:30 o'clock, a.m. and 4:00 o'clock p.m. prevailing time in the office of the Township Secretary.

Pursuant to the First-Class Township Code, this ordinance will become effective on or about July 13, 2026.

All residents, taxpayers, and persons interested therein or affected thereby who wish to object, must challenge the validity of the Ordinance by legal action within thirty (30) days of the second publication of this notice.
