Attention Allendale Residents

Many new families have moved into the neighborhood and are unaware of some guidelines that help keep Allendale safe and attractive. All trash containers and trash must be placed on grass above the curb, not in the street unless your yard is on a hill and it is impossible to put containers on the grass.

It is illegal to shoot grass into the street when you are cutting your yards. It is dangerous for motorcyclists, bicyclists and even walkers when it rains and gets slippery. It also goes into the drains and into the Chesapeake watershed – illegal. The township does send letters of warning and then fines when they are aware of people doing this.

Taking 5 minutes to run your mower over the sidewalk after finishing the cutting will get the grass off the sidewalk. If someone slips and falls because of the grass covering your sidewalk, you are responsible for all medical bills for that person! Please, be a good neighbor and cut your grass, but keep it out of the street and off the sidewalks.

Safety Reminders

Daylight will soon be getting shorter and nightfall earlier. Some streets in Allendale have no sidewalks. It is important for those walking at dusk or in the dark to wear reflective gear. It is very difficult to see pedestrians without it. Please keep safe and help avoid a tragedy. Wear reflective gear, please!!!!

Some areas in Allendale are pitch dark at night because the residents don't have their outside lights turned on. Many people walk their dogs at night and the lack of visibility creates a dangerous situation. Please be considerate to your neighbors and turn on your outside lighting or put them on a timer. It may save someone from getting injured.
